






Description of the EasyAcc'Air sectional door controls






To operate the door:


- Check the vehicle's main power supply (battery main switch)
- Check that the emergency stop is deactivated (reference 6)


After being switched on, the system needs 15 seconds to start up

• Open and stop the sectional door



Close the sectional door






• If there is a malfunction




Check that the door is not locked




• Secure the cargo after closing the sectional door









• Open the sectional door manually in the event of an emergency









Troubleshooting

What could be the cause of the failure and are you able to fix it yourself?

Before calling the technical support department for advice, check the status of the cab lights (reference 1). If the problem persists after you have completed the recommended checks, call the Lecapitaine After-Sales Service and they will be able to help.

Steady	Door closed and sealed	Ok	Permission to drive, door sealed and maintained by the inflatable seal
Switched off	Door not closed, no error detected		Door closure required for travel
Steady	General circuit board failure		Manual use of the door and permission to drive if door locked (reference 3). Sealing not provided
Flashing	Pneumatic fault		
1 flash	Power supply failure		
2 flashes	Motor failure	Start up the vehicle. Restart the system using the emergency stop (reference 6). If the light remains on, contact the After-Sales Service	Manual use of the door and permission to drive if door locked (reference 3). Sealing may be provided by control references 2, 4 and 8
3 flashes	Presence sensor failure		Slow door speed because presence sensor out of service, locking and sealing operational
4 flashes	Upper limit switch failure		Slow door speed because limit switch out of service,
5 flashes	Lower limit switch failure		locking and sealing operational
Steady	Maintenance due	Contact the After-Sales Service	Replace the balancing spring: failure imminent

Buzzer	Door condition	Impact
